There are two patterns for questions:    ❶ Do you xxxx?    ❷ Are you xxxx?

❶ VERBS:	I like pop music. I want a vacation. He watches TV. They work in the city.		Do you like pop music? Do you want a vacation? Does he watch TV? Do they work in the city?
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❷ ADJECTIVES	He is tall. I am happy. Boston is crowded. English is easy.		Is he tall? Are you happy? Is Boston crowded? Is English easy?
